

**TOWN OF WILTON NEW HAMPSHIRE
SEWER USE AND CONNECTIONS
SEPTEMBER 2015**

Wilton's Sewer System is a user of the Milford Wastewater Treatment Plant and is subject to terms of an Intermunicipal Wastewater Agreement mandated by Federal and State laws. The Wilton Sewer System is overseen by a three-member commission elected at Town Meeting. (Unless there is a vacancy, one commissioner is elected each year and serves a three year term.) The Wilton Sewer Commission meets on the second Thursday of the month in the Town Hall Courtroom at 6:30PM. Meetings are Open to the Public.

All new sewer residential services to be connected to the existing sewer system shall be subject a one-time connection / entrance fee of \$900. A minimum ¾" supply line is required. The Customer is responsible for payment for work done on his own property (from the connection at the street to his building) and may also be responsible for payment for work done to make service available to his property if not yet available.

*Sewer Rents and Assessments A semi-annual (or other frequency established by the Sewer Commission) charge ... Currently – 9/2015 - **RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS ARE BILLED \$90 PER QUARTER.***

All fees and assessments shall be paid to the TOWN OF WILTON.

Additionally, per the Wilton Sewer Ordinance, there are two (2) classes of building sewer permits: (A) for residential and commercial service discharging only domestic wastewater and (B) for service to establishments producing industrial wastes. In either case, the owner or his agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the Board of Sewer Commissioners. The permit application shall be supplemented by any plans, specifications or other information considered pertinent in the judgment of the Board of Sewer Commissioners.

There shall be a permit application and inspection fee of fifty (\$50) dollars for a residential or commercial building sewer permit and seventy-five (\$75) dollars for an industrial building sewer permit, paid to the Town of Wilton at the time the application is filed. Twenty-five (\$25) dollars will be retained as a processing charge, if a sewer permit is not granted.

The Owner(s) of all houses, buildings or properties used for human occupancy, employment, recreation or other purposes situated within Wilton and abutting on any street, alley or right-of-way in which there is now located a public sanitary sewer of Wilton is hereby required, at the Owner(s) expense, to install suitable toilet facilities therein, and to connect such facilities directly with the proper public sewer in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance within ninety (90) days after the date of official notice to do so provided that said public sewer is within one hundred (100) feet (30.5 meters) (200 ft 61 meters) of the building.

Discharges into the Sewer System shall not cause obstruction to the flow or interfere with the proper operation of the wastewater facilities. Prohibited are disposal of ashes, bones, cinders, sand, mud, straw, shavings, metal, glass, rags, feathers, tar, plastics, wood, un-ground garbage, whole blood, paunch manure, hair, fleshings and entrails and paper dishes, cups, milk containers, **disposable diapers and wipes, tampons, sanitary napkins, bandages**, etc., either whole or ground by garbage grinders.
