

TOWN OF WILTON

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

Date: February 13, 2012

Time: 6:30 P.M.

Place: Town Office

Present: Chairman Daniel E. Donovan III, Selectman William F. Condra, and Recording Secretary Pamela Atwood; Selectman McDonough was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M.

Steve Elliott and Roger Keilig attended the meeting to discuss the drainage issue behind the Town Hall. Roger presented his plan and explained the results of the borings up back and said that observation wells have been placed there. Roger explained that the back wall of the Town Hall goes 17 feet below ground and acts as a dam for roughly five feet of water. Roger's plan is to put two wells in with pumps that would pump into existing basins or a pipe gallery to drain to a catch basin further away. Costs were discussed and Steve Elliott estimated that \$20,000 would get this project started. Chairman Donovan and Selectman Condra agreed that this would be a good place to start and that part of the Capital Reserve fund could be used to pay for it. After some discussion from the audience Chairman Donovan made a motion.

Motion: Chairman Donovan made a motion to take \$20,000 out of the Town Hall Repair Project Capital Reserve Fund to use for the drainage repairs as discussed with Roger Keilig. Selectman Condra seconded. A unanimous vote followed.

Chairman Donovan and Selectman Condra talked about the mobile home on Mike Davidson's land. It was decided that the Board would send a letter to Mr. Davidson since he was not returning Chairman

Donovan's phone calls.

The Bennington Battle Trail issue was discussed. The Board will send a letter to the owner.

The next item on the agenda was the Water Department's faulty software interface. Selectman Condra wanted this item to be addressed. He explained how the Water and Sewer Department's new billing system was not working well. The software interface that communicates to Jane's computer was not working, so all payments being made by the water and sewer users have been piling up. Selectman Condra suggested that it would have been in everyone's best interest if the Water and Sewer Commissioners had tested the software before going live with it. Chairman Donovan asked Bob Duquette to comment. Bob did agree that there have been problems and he hopes that they will be straighten out shortly. He also stated that by June, Centrix Bank or another bank will be handling the payments. Chairman Donovan concluded that he hopes the problems get fixed soon.

The Selectmen agreed to get an additional quote to have the Town Hall backflow device repaired and/or retested due to the recent failed test.

Chairman Donovan spoke about the loose slate tile on the Town Hall roof and how the Fire Department secured it. He will follow up with Chief Dick.

One abatement application was approved.
Payroll was approved.
The manifests for the week were approved.

At 7:22 P.M. Chairman Donovan made a motion to go into non-public session to discuss a personnel issue per RSA 91-A:3(a). The motion was seconded by Selectman Condra followed by a unanimous vote.

The regular meeting was called back to order at 8:01 P.M. and with no further business to transact the meeting was adjourned at 8:02 P.M.
