

# TOWN OF WILTON

## SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

Date: February 27, 2012

Time: 6:30 P.M.

Place: Town Office

Present: Selectmen Steven McDonough and William F. Condra, and Recording Secretary Pamela Atwood. Chairman Donovan was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Selectman McDonough.

John Shepardson attended the meeting. He wanted to discuss the problems he has with local gas companies that install tanks and gas lines without permits. John suggested issuing fines to the companies as he feels he has no real leverage with them. Selectman Condra suggested that John follow the procedures outlined on the permits; Bill believes it states that the permit fee can be doubled if found to be operating without a permit. Also, a "stop" work order can be issued and the owner notified.

Next, John initiated a discussion about the Allen property. After a lengthy discussion, it was determined that the Board would contact Town Counsel to discuss updating the Court Order and the ramifications of letting it lapse.

Road Agent Steve Elliott was on the agenda next. He came in to discuss the large tree on Maple Street by Michaud's Funeral Home. Mr. Michaud has asked Mr. Elliott for his opinion about removing the tree. After some discussion the Board agreed that the tree belongs to Mr. Michaud, therefore, he would be responsible for removing it, but the Town would help clean up the stump and re-pave afterward.

Next on the agenda was Bob Duquette. He attended the meeting to

discuss his tax assessment. He was not satisfied with the revised assessment he got from the Assessor. After further discussion it was decided that the Assessor will come in to talk to Bob and the Board.

Bob Duquette also mentioned a contract NHDOT has available for fuel purchases. It was noted that this is a program that several town departments already take advantage of.

Selectman Condra noted that Bill Chalmers wanted to speak to the Selectmen. Mr. Chalmers discussed the procedure of procuring a DD214 form for eligibility for the Veteran's Exemption. Mr. Chalmers left his DD214 with the Selectmen and requested that it be mailed back to him when done.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:23 P.M.

Kellie Boissonnault heard the motion and inquired about the Warrant Articles. Selectman Condra informed Ms. Boissonnault that a special meeting had been posted and held last Thursday to vote on the Warrant Articles.

Hearing no further questions at 7:25 P.M., Selectman McDonough made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Selectman Condra followed by a unanimous vote.
