SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

DATE: April 2, 2012

TIME: 6:30 PM

PLACE: Town Office

PRESENT: Selectmen Steven McDonough, Chair, William Condra and Daniel Donovan, III and Recording Secretary Peggy Arn

Chairman Steven McDonough called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. He then entertained a motion to adjourn the regular meeting and to enter into a non public session per RSA 91A:3,II© to hear Tax Collector Jane Farrell.

Chairman McDonough called the regular meeting to order at 6:55.

Ambulance Chief attended the meeting to inform the Board that he would does not have enough people for him to teach an EMT class this year. He would like to send interested persons to another class which would be at the Academy of First Response. He would reimburse the student that joins the Ambulance and has been certified \$400. After the person has been a member for a year, and if approved in the budget, they will be given the second \$400. The Board agreed to his request for this year and then if approved by the Budget Committee, next year also.

Gary stated that the bids for the water treatment system had been received and wanted to know how to get reimbursed from the Florence Wheeler Fund.

The quotes were:

Capitalwell Clean Water Center \$3,468.00

Secondwind Water Systems \$6,365.00

Skillings & Sons, Inc. \$3,665.00

Gary stated that his choice would be Capitalwell Clean Water Center. The Board unanimously agreed with his choice.

Gary then informed the Board of the quotes he had received for the repairs to the Ambulance Bay roof.

The quotes were:

Henry Gibbons Improvements \$10,500.00

An additional if rear of building rafter was extended out

To match the rest of the building \$3,700.00 Total \$14,200.00

Walter Holt \$11,810.00

Goodine Builders, LLC \$12,600.00

Maillet Construction \$13,528.00

Turnstone Corporation \$30,000.00

Mr. Zirpolo told the Board that he would like to award the contract to Henry Gibbons based on his reputation and quality of work. The Board agreed and supported the work being award to Henry Gibbons.

Chairman McDonough made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded and all in favor. He then called a non public session per RSA 91-A:3,II©.

Chairman McDonough calls the regular meeting of the Board to order at 8:00 PM.

The bills for the week were reviewed and approved. Correspondence and informational material was reviewed.

The Board reviewed two recommendations made by the Town Assessor and unanimously decided that no action should be taken at

this time.

The Board reviewed and signed one Notice of Property Lien for a welfare recipient and one Intent to Cut Lumber.

The meeting was adjourned on a motion, with all in favor at 8:35 PM.
