## SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

Date: May 7, 2012

Time: 6:30 P.M.

Place: Town Office

Present: Chairman Steven J. McDonough, Selectman William F. Condra, and Recording Secretary Pamela Atwood. Selectman Donovan was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chairman McDonough.

Payroll was approved.

Two (2) Intent-to-Cut notices were approved.

The minutes were approved.

The manifests for the week were approved.

The informational material was reviewed.

The Board talked about the letters that were going to be sent to the towns that assisted in the house fire on Maple Street. Chairman McDonough suggested mailing the letters to the Fire Chiefs with a copy going to the Selectmen.

The Board looked at the proposal for asbestos abatement removal at the Fire State.

The Board discussed the backflow inspection letter sent out by the Water Department. Chairman McDonough agreed with what Selectman Donovan had previously stated; if the inspections can be done by another company at a less expensive price then that is what we will do.

Bob Duquette was on the agenda next to discuss the results of his

abatement application. He received a check from the Town for a revision to his assessment, and he asked the Board if he would lose his right to appeal if he cashes the check. He stated that he would like something in writing that says he does not lose his right to appeal if he cashes the check. The board will ask the Assessor to write a letter. Mr. Duquette stated that he was going to appeal to the State anyway.

Bob asked if the check would be ready tomorrow for the truck the Water Department was buying for their new employee.

The summer schedule for Board meetings was discussed.

Motion: Chairman McDonough made a motion to begin the summer schedule. Beginning with the June 4th meeting the Board will meet every other Monday. Selectman Condra seconded the motion followed by a vote with all in favor.
