## **MEETING MINUTES**

### **MONDAY – 14TH JULY 2014 – 7:00 PM**

The Wilton Conservation Commission held its Regular Monthly Meeting on Monday, 14 JULY 2014, at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall.

Leslie Tallarico called the meeting to order at 7:15pm.

- Chairperson for the meeting: Spencer made a Motion to have Les Tallarico Chair this meeting, Jeff Second the motion, all those in favor eye. Motion Passed.
- Minutes –Spencer makes a motion that we table the June Minutes until the July meeting for approval, (Donna to send out in an email, with the changes to be made prior to the meeting), Bill Second the Motion all those in favor Eye. Motion Passes.

Motion Passed. Les made a motion that the WCC Clerk write the letter to the Selectmen notifying them of the changes that have been voted on, Joe Second the Motion, all in favor Eye. Motion Passed.
- ZBA – Meeting of July 8th (NTV CASE) end result RSA said a non conforming structure loses is grandfathered, changes in the laws had changed the balance in favor of applicant. & 9th, and 11th, (BABINEAU TRUST & CONRAD Cases) extension granted ,
