SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

Date: November 5, 2012

Time: 6:30 P.M.

Place: Town Office

Present: Chairman Steven J. McDonough, Selectmen Daniel E. Donovan, III, and William F. Condra and Recording Secretary Pamela Atwood.

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 P.M. by Chairman McDonough.

There were no appointments on the agenda so the Board started with their paperwork.

The minutes were approved.

Payroll for period ending 11/03/12 was approved.

The perambulation paperwork submitted by the Town of Lyndeborough was signed.

The Board reviewed the bond cancellation paperwork that was received in the mail and asked that it be forwarded on to the Planning Board.

The Selectmen reviewed the letter from Attorney Little regarding Mr. Gabel.

Motion: Selectman Condra made a motion to appoint Tom Schultz to fill the unexpired term of resigned Sewer Commissioner Bob Duquette. The motion was seconded by Selectman Donovan and followed by a unanimous vote.

The Selectmen discussed the problem with the Ambulance Bay generator during Hurricane Sandy. The Ambulance Bay is equipped

with three-phase power; however, there is nothing in the building that requires three-phase. Chief Zirpolo will get a price to put a single-phase service in the building which would mean a less expensive generator could be purchased.

The Board approved the estimates for painting offices in the Town Hall and installing new flooring in the theater restrooms.

Chairman McDonough would like to get two bids for the repairs needed on the Town Hall roof.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:07 P.M. by Chairman McDonough, seconded by Selectman Condra followed by a vote with all in favor.
