MINUTES OF MEETING

MONDAY – 8th December 2014 – 7:00 PM

The Wilton Conservation Commission held its Regular Monthly Meeting on
Monday, 8th of December 2014, at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall.

- **Bart Hunter, Chairman:** called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm
- **Visitors:** Tracey Ewig – Observing

Old Business:

- **Minutes:** Review/Approve Meeting Minutes for November 10th. Bill made a motion to accept the minutes, Spencer second, all in favor. Minutes Accepted.
- **Budget & Expenditures:** Review & Update.
 - a. Discuss 2015 Meeting with Budget Com. Bart seemed to go very well, the only issue was whether the town will adjust the \$2,800 from the WCC property maintenance amount in our budget or put it under another Town budget line. Either way it comes out of the town final budget.
 - b. Bart has an invoice for \$60.00 from attending the NHACC Seminar. Bill made a motion to pay the invoice, Spencer second the motion. All in favor. Invoice to be paid, signed by Jeff Stone to be paid. Donna will hand deliver to Pam.
- **ZBA:** December Meeting was cancelled.
- **Planning Board:** No Cases at this time that require our attention
- **Forest Management:**
 - a. Discussing a possible designation of Prime Wetlands. These wetlands were discussed as possible candidates: Burton Pond and Brook North of Burton Highway. Burton Brook South of Burton Highway between Isaac Frye and Davisville Road: Stephenson property is an idea. The brook expands quite a distance and it could be a way of highlighting

certain areas. If you are thinking enforcement this would be like any wetlands, by the state very poorly drained is prime.

- b. Fall property monitoring update and discussion. Someone posted “No Trespassing” signs on Hoover’s property. They can post “No Hunting” signs. There is an easement on the property and it can’t be posted “No Trespassing” Alan contacted the Hoover's they didn't post the signs. Alan is looking for something in writing before he takes down the signs. Note: some people have spent some time setting up cross country signs need to find out who? Also someone dropped off a pile of brush at the site, Alan will take care of it.
 - c. Abbot Hill field there is a pin they can't find in the North East corner. Bart and Joe are planning on following up. lot H41
