#### MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

The Towns of Wilton, Lyndeborough and Greenfield continue to benefit by being served by a dedicated group of individuals that work together to provide the best care possible when citizens call for help.

In 2020 we responded to 297 calls in Wilton, 96 calls in Lyndeborough, 125 calls in Greenfield and 29 mutual aid responses for a total of 547 calls. Of these calls 25 were 2<sup>nd</sup> calls, of which Wilton Ambulance covered 17 and 8 required a mutual aid ambulance. This means that 98.5 % of the calls were handled by Wilton Ambulance and 1.5% required mutual aid.

Wilton Ambulance currently has 2 Ford F450 4x4 ambulances. One is a 2014 and one is a 2017. The 2014 is scheduled to be replaced in 2024. We also have a 2019 Chevy Tahoe, which is used as our Rapid Response Vehicle.

Our primary ambulance is staffed (from the station) 24/7 with a Paramedic and an EMT/AEMT. Our current staffing consists of 9 Paramedics, 6 AEMT's, 9 EMT's and 2 drivers.

We are looking to implement a "daily check in" process for anyone interested in being contacted by the ambulance crew (via the number you provide) to check on your wellbeing. We will also be offering a free vial for life kit. By utilizing the vial for life, we will have pertinent information regarding your medical history and any medication you take. This will help us, help you. If you are interested in either of these programs, please contact Wilton Ambulance directly (654-2222) or your Town Administrator.



# **OVERVIEW**

The Town of Wilton Ambulance proudly serves the Towns of Wilton, Lyndeborough, and Greenfield. We also provide Mutual Aid to neighboring towns when requested. Our Department strives to provide exceptional pre-hospital quality care at the Basic Life Support and Advanced Life Support Level 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Our Service has evolved from a non-profit 501c3 Ambulance Association that was an all-volunteer, EMT level ambulance service covering the towns of Wilton and Lyndeborough in 1974 to a Municipal Department with Paramedic coverage handling 547 calls in 2020.

We presently have on staff:

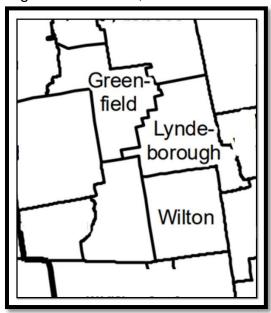
- 9 Paramedics

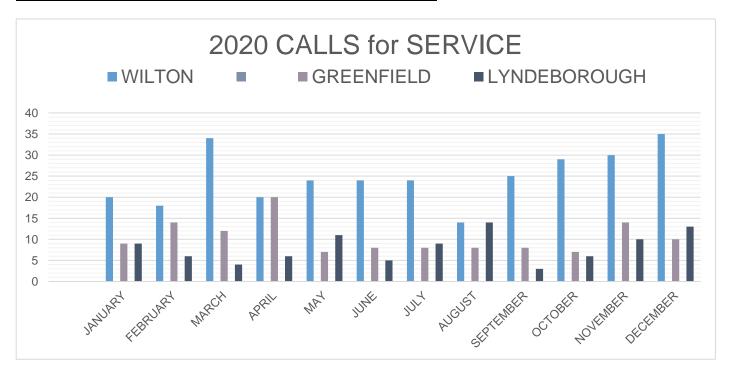

# **CALL VOLUME**

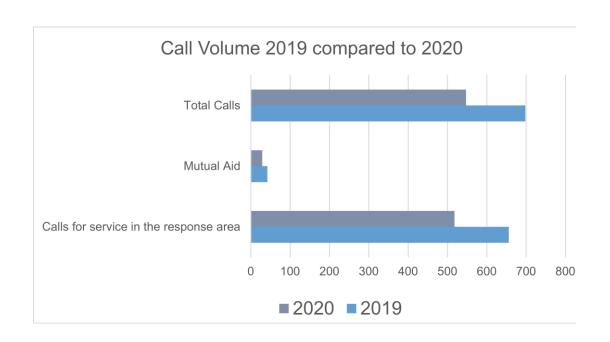

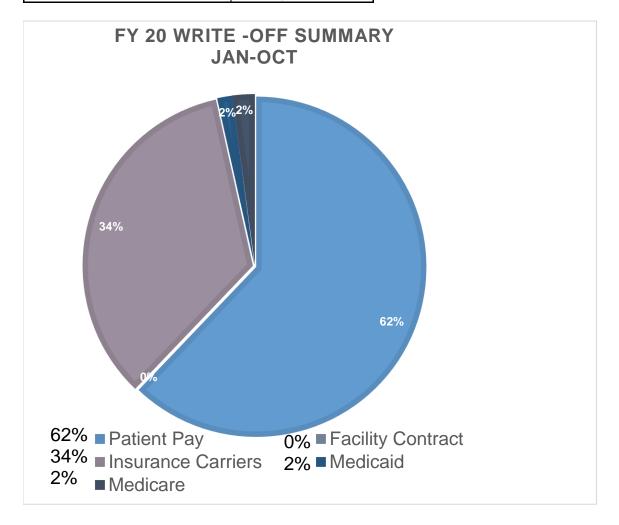

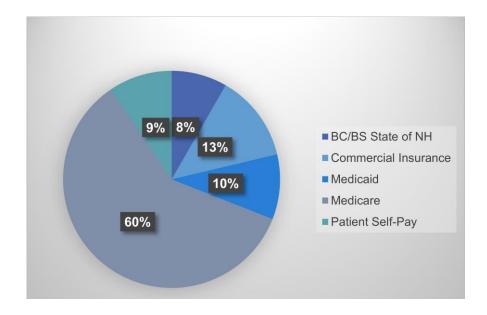

### **Equipment, Capital Assets and Expenses**

Currently we have 2 Ford F-450 4x4 Ambulances, and a 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe as our Rapid Response Vehicle. Our 1st Ambulance is a 2017 and is dedicated as 30A1. Our 2nd Ambulance is a 2014 and is dedicated as 30A2. Our department has purchased a New 2019 Chevrolet Tahoe to replace our old Rapid Response Vehicle and is dedicated as 30EMS1.

We rotate our ambulances as the Primary Unit from month to month. Meaning one month we use 30A2 as the Primary Ambulance and the next month 30A1 is used as Primary.

Other equipment consists of:

- 2018 Ambulance Lease- \$36,549.03 Annual Lease Payment
- Cardiac Monitors-\$17,260.00 Annual Lease Payment
- 2019 Response Vehicle- \$45,000- paid in full 2020

In 2021 a RAD-57 will be funded by the Florence Wheeler fund in the Amount of \$4,000.00
