

Town of Wilton Ambulance Employment Opportunity Per-Diem Paramedic

The Town of Wilton Ambulance Service is accepting applications for the position of Per-Diem Paramedic. The Wilton Ambulance Service is a municipal ambulance service that serves approximately 7,000 citizens of the towns of Wilton, Lyndeborough, Greenfield and Temple, NH. Our call volume is approximately 600 calls per year.

This position is for mostly evening, overnight, and weekend shifts with some weekday day shifts available. Per-Diem Paramedics are able to respond from within 6 miles of our Forest Road, Wilton facility.

The salary scale for this position is \$14.00 – \$21.50/hour commensurate with experience.

Minimum qualifications for the position of Per-Diem Paramedic are:

- New Hampshire Provider License, or able to obtain a New Hampshire Provider License.
- National Registry of EMT's, Paramedic or EMT-Paramedic Certification
- Current American Heart Association Advanced Cardiac Life Support Provider certification
- Current American Heart Association Pediatric Advanced Life Support certification
- Current American Heart Association BLS for HCP, or American Red Cross Professional Rescuer.
- Able to perform as a Paramedic up to the NHTSA's Functional Job Analysis for Paramedics
