To donate candy:

Donations must be in the original sealed package and dropped off at Wilton Library, Wilton Town Hall or Lyndeborough Town Hall from October 1st through October 19th, 2019.

To qualify to receive candy:

Check the map to see if your household will qualify for donated candy. If you are an adult in the designated area, and sign up with the Wilton Town Clerk or the Wilton Library, you qualify!

To receive candy:

Pick-up will be available during regular Wilton Library and Wilton Town Hall hours between Monday October 21st, 2019, and Wednesday October 30th, 2019.

Only registered households may pick up. Identification and proof of residency will be required. An adult must pick up the candy, and there will be only one pick-up per household. Amounts distributed will depend on the amount donated.
