MESSAGE FOR WILTON RESIDENTS

From the Wilton Select Board Office

This message to our residents is to explain how the Tax Rate for 2019 has been set.

The total tax rate is made up of the municipal tax, local school tax, state education tax and the Hillsborough County tax. The only component of the total tax rate regulated by the Town is the municipal portion. The other three components of the total tax rate, which represents 70% of the total tax rate, receives no oversight by the Town.

For 2019 the Town tax rate has been reduced by 0.05 cents from \$7.98 to \$7.93 while the School tax rate has increased by 0.39 cents from \$17.37 to \$17.76 per thousand. The County tax rate went up 0.02 cents from \$1.20 to \$1.22 and the state education tax rate decreased 0.08 cents from \$2.21 to \$2.13.

This produced an overall **tax rate of \$29.04** per thousand for 2019.

Going forward your municipal government will continue to do its best to control its portion of the tax rate while providing the best possible services to its residents.

We encourage you to be more involved with both the Town and the School District to provide input that helps to influence policy.
