Open Cupboard Pantry (OCP)

- The OCP is an emergency food source for residents of Temple, Wilton, Lyndeborough, and Greenfield. We believe that no one should be without food.
- We have been in service for 22 years and are located in the Wilton Falls Building across from the Wilton Police Station at 6 Burns Hill Road.
- We are open by appointment and request 24 hour notice, *if possible*. It has been our experience that people prefer to have their *own* designated shopping time.
- The OCP is staffed solely by volunteers, some working as much as 20 hours/week.
- *No one in an emergency situation has ever been turned away.*
- The people who come to the Pantry have different needs. Some come once a year, some once a month and some every two weeks.
- When families' needs are continuing, we encourage them to apply for food stamps, fuel assistance, and other services, and also come to the Pantry regularly for supplemental groceries.
- Families who come to the Pantry regularly need to meet state income guidelines.
- The OCP is totally supported by donations from the generous individuals and organizations from the towns we serve. All donations are tax deductible.
- Unlike most food pantries, OCP shoppers are able to walk through the aisles choosing for themselves what food items they need. We stock meat, fresh bread, eggs, butter, fruits and vegetables, baking supplies, toiletries, diapers, as well as canned goods and cereals.
- Financial donations may be made by mailing to; The Open Cupboard Pantry, PO Box 111, Wilton, NH. Food donations may be dropped at the Pantry after calling, or we will pick up. Market Basket also has a donation barrel for the OCP as you enter the right side entry doors.
